

To receive an **A** grade in choir you must:

1. Participate in class on a daily basis. Come prepared with music, pencil, and a good attitude. Be on task and respectful of other people.
2. Be at all rehearsals and concerts on time, perform in them and “check out” at the end. Please check the calendar online to verify dates. Dates change periodically, please make sure that you check the Calendar often.
3. Prepare and perform a solo song for the class. Guidelines for your final are on the Resources page.
  - a. You need to have your music and accompaniment by October 13th.
  - b. You must video yourself performing your solo and answer the “Solo Video Reflection” questions. The reflection is due November 27th.
  - c. These finals will be performed beginning Dec 4th.
  - d. Write a one page “Final Solo Reflection” of the preparation process, and performance of your solo. Due December 19th.
4. Complete your level based assignments which will be due throughout the semester.
5. Complete the fall semester requirements for your Portfolio. You will be given the requirements and their due dates in class.
6. Have no more than five excused absences. Each subsequent **excused** absence will result in a drop of 20 points from your overall grade.
7. Complete and pass all quizzes, tests and take home assignments. This includes Sight Reading Factory and Practice First Assignments.
8. Turn in all forms. This includes, but is not limited to, the Concussion Forms, Sports/Activity Liability Form, Field Trip Forms, etc.
9. **EXTRA CREDIT:** Extra credit is available to students who are missing points. Options for extra credit can be found on the choir website under **Resources**.
