

## Music – What Can You Do With It

Research what careers or jobs you can do with training in music or singing.

### Part One:

1. Find three careers or jobs related to music and/or singing.
2. Two of them may be something potentially obvious to the music industry. One must NOT be anything considered obvious (singer in a band, music teacher, opera singer, etc.) – music may only be a part of the ‘career’ – or training in music helps even if not the actual job. Find this, invent it, get creative in your thinking!!
3. Write a 3-5 line paragraph describing or explaining each job (make sure it mentions how music and/or singing is related to it, influences it, helps it, etc.)

### Part Two:

1. Pick one of the career areas in Part One – focus on the one you’d be most interested in (whether you actually want this job or not – something that might be applicable to you)
2. Write 1-2 lines on how each of the following areas affects the job, training, preparedness, etc.: Science, English, Math, History (you’ll find some answers obvious and others might be a stretch – that’s okay)

### Part Three:

1. Find someone in one of the areas of interest that you have and interview them.
  - a. Come up with a set of interview questions that are relevant to the field in which the person works
  - b. Schedule an interview with someone in the field
  - c. Conduct an interview that lasts no longer than 20 minutes
  - d. Record your interview so that you can write down their responses
2. Type out your interview in a “Question-Answer” format like you would see in a magazine.

Turn in the writing from each part of the assignment.
